


1 | UNFOLD Remove the X tent from the carry bag and unfold the frame.

3 | TIGHTEN VALVES Each leg have 1 inflate / deflate valve and 1 overpressure valve. Tighten the valves.










#### ABOUT THE PRESSURE

Inflate untill the tube feels very solid (3PSI/0.2BAR). The remaining air will escape through the overpressure valve.
















## POSITIONING

5 | POSITIONING LEGS
Drive 8 stakes into the ground at an angle of 40 degrees .
When you cannot use stakes on solid ground ,
you can buckle 4 water barrels to the 4 legs .




Only use water with a soft handbrush and a wet cloth to clean the tent. Do not use any cleaning products.
